Comments: The Aspen Art Museum picnic performed well in the area of waste reduction. Trash cans were available alongside of recycle and compost bins. Bins were readily accessible, clearly marked, and seemed to have little contamination. Reusable table linens were used and cutlery and dishes were compostable. No Styrofoam take-out containers were distributed. Compost bins were emptied regularly which helped prevent overflow. A vegetarian meal was provided and water was distributed from bulk containers with cups; no bottled water. There was a handout printed on 100% recycled paper. The Aspen Art Museum did not appear to have educated attendees about their greening efforts. Please let us know if we are mistaken. There were no sponsors or vendors at the event, so giveaways and printed material were minimal. Overall, great job with waste reduction efforts!
