**Comments:** The Boogie's Buddy 5 Mile did a good job of meeting the ZGreen requirements. Except for printed materials (recycled content unknown), giveaways were consumable (food and drink) or reusable (T-shirts). Tap water (nice job!) was provided and cups were recyclable plastic. Entry forms were printed on 100% recycled paper and the amount printed was reduced from 1,500 to 300 this year. The snacks were easy to eat and pre-cut, which meant there was minimal food waste and no need for dishes or utensils. Water was provided in bulk to avoid bottled water. A special bin was provided to collect wrappers from energy bars for Terracycle recycling.

Thank you for working hard to meet the ZGreen event requirements. There is still room for improvement next year with regard to education. Although there were signs posted at check-in, more could be done to educate participants about the event's efforts to be environmentally friendly.
