The CUE exchange did a great job of achieving voluntary ZGreen certification. The giveaways were reusable and made from recycled content paper, helping reduce waste. Using the Aspen Meadows' waste stations allowed for comingled and newspaper recycling in all areas of the event. The educational sign was posted at the check-in area so that attendees could read about how the event was green. Nice work. A vegetarian option was provided and no bottled water was available.

Opportunities for Improvement:

The coffee station still had a few different types of sugar in small packets. ZGreen recommends the CUE provide all items like this in bulk to further reduce waste. Also, attendees should have been encouraged to use reusable coffee cups instead of paper cups.
