Comments (based on ZGreen checklist requirements including employee knowledge, education, giveaways, printing, waste stations, bulk distribution, water, and decorations):

The Criterium met the ZGreen requirements in 2013. Trash and recycle bins were available, and were paired at the registration table and the City's permanent bins were available around the course. No dishes or cutlery were available, which eliminates the concern for compostable-ware. In the future, ZGreen still recommends communicating with vendors before the event regarding serving ware if there is any to be had. Breakfast items were made available in bulk containers. A vegetarian meal was provided and water was distributed from bulk containers with cups; no bottled water. Nice work.

Opportunities for Improvement:

Volunteers did not receive training on green practices prior to the event, and there was no evidence of trying to educate attendees about green efforts. ZGreen requires all event planners to actively educate event attendees about the environmental efforts of that event. Because the Criterium is hosted by the City of Aspen, the educational effort should be very visible as an example to other events.
