## **THE EVENT:**

Aspen will *hope* to host up to 10 students and their teacher chaperones from its Sister City, Chamonix, France in February 2015. As our guests, the French students and teachers will stay with host families and experience our culture. Chamonix will then host our students and teacher chaperones in April 2015. The students and teachers will stay with families in Chamonix. The group will attend school, and cultural functions, go sightseeing, and shopping, as well as participate in local activities.

## **THE COMMITMENT:**

1. **Fund-raising & Family Participation:** Each student and his/her family will be expected to help with various fund-raising events throughout the summer and the following school year. Families will also need to attend all organizational meetings and be prepared to supervise activities in order to make this exchange a success. In essence, this program must be very high on the activity priority list.
2. **Study:** All students must be currently enrolled in a school French class or be willing to be tutored in French. Students will also be expected to participate in several after school, cultural awareness classes before their spring trip.
3. **Presentations:** Students will need to prepare speeches and slide shows to be given in Chamonix and in Aspen upon their return.
4. **Hosting:** Each family will be required to host a French student in February 2015 (if they come) for approximately two weeks. Our students will then go stay with the same student in Chamonix in April 2015.
5. **Money:** Every family should be prepared to pay up to \$2000 and of that money students need to earn, on their own, at least \$350 toward the trip to demonstrate their personal commitment. Scholarships are available, but requests must be made using a scholarship form and must then be submitted with the original application – please call Georgina Levey at 948-8629 if more information is necessary.
6. **Eligibility:** Students cannot receive a grade of a D or an F in any subject on a report card. Secondly, students who receive serious behavioral consequences (i.e. out-of-school suspension, expulsion, etc) or who make poor behavioral choices outside of school may be dismissed from the program at the discretion of school administrators.

## **THE APPLICATION PROCESS:**

**Note:** Students will be chosen from the Aspen Middle School, the Aspen Country Day School and the Aspen Community School.

1. Complete the attached application form.
2. Write a short essay about the similarities and differences between Aspen and the country you want to visit (see application for more information).
3. Be available for an interview during the week of April 7-11, 2014.
4. **Submit your application to Maria Carbonetti at ACDS, Jolaine Pfeifer at AMS or Hilary Forsyth at ACS no later than Wednesday, April 2, 2014 at 3:30 PM.**
5. Participants will be chosen mid- May. The first organizational meeting will be at the end of May.
