

Designed by Frank Hummel, the Aspen Golf Club provides a challenging 18-hole course set in the heart of the Rockies and Roaring Fork Valley. Just minutes from downtown Aspen, this 7,156-yard championship course is complete with a PGA award-winning Golf Shop, practice hitting area, chipping green, putting green, cart rentals, as well as full-service locker rooms. Group and private instruction is available by PGA staff and may be scheduled by calling the golf shop or emailing one of the PGA Professionals. Rio and Wagner are superb venues for many of our world-famous events, such as the Food and Wine Festival, Rotary's Ducky Derby, or special musical or educational happenings. Visit our downtown Pedestrian Mall for shopping and dining, or enjoy the excitement at our state-of-the-art Rio Grande Skateboard Park. Over 30 parks and playgrounds are available for everything from picnics, weddings, and reunions to special events such as antique fairs and kids' carnivals.

Being located in the heart of the downtown core Wagner Park is one of the most visited and used parks within the City of Aspen. Wagner Park is essentially a professional sized rugby field, but is used for many other events throughout the year. Adjacent to the park is a public restroom facility, and a very popular playground area within the pedestrian walking mall. Come and bring your kids, dogs, or lunch and enjoy one of Aspen's iconic parks with breath taking views of Aspen Mountain. This park holds major special events only, such as the Food and Wine Classic, and unfortunately is usually not available to rent.





RIO GRANDE PARK



Rio Grande Park is the City of Aspen's largest park within city limits. This park contains a professional size rugby field, State-of-Art Skate Park, Theatre Aspen, Basketball Court, John Denver Sanctuary, also Aspen's Recycle Center. This multi-functional park is used for major special events, sporting events, etc. Rio Grande Park is located just south of the downtown core off of Mill Street and Rio Grande Place. You can find picnic tables, benches, water fountains, and other basic park amenities throughout the park.

John Denver Sanctuary

John Denver Sanctuary is a scenic, highly desirable venue located in the heart of downtown Aspen next to the Roaring Fork River. Within the sanctuary is the largest perennial flower garden around, which attracts visitors from around the globe. Amidst the gardens you will find an environmentally sound wetlands filter system. Artistically placed engraved landscape rocks add to the overall ambiance and story behind the sanctuary. This location is also the home to Theater Aspen in the summer, providing live stage entertainment to hundreds.

KOCH LUMBER PARK

Located just west of the downtown core, Koch Lumber Park is another very attractive park to many locals and visitors alike. This park contains some of the few public sand volleyball courts available in Aspen. Koch Park attracts events of all forms from birthday parties to the professional volleyball tournaments.



HERRON PARK

This is one of our most popular parks used by the locals and their kids. On any given day you will find people in this park. The beginning of the 40 Mile Rio Grande Trail starts in Herron Park. This park is also adjacent to the Roaring Fork River, which attracts people and dogs of all ages to come play in the river. The large open lawn and playground is a very attractive spot to come play and enjoy your day.



GLORY HOLE PARK

Legend has it that at the bottom of Glory Hole Pond lies an old locomotive engine, well that doesn't stop the dogs from enjoying a nice cool dip. The pond is fed directly from the Roaring Fork River. Numerous benches are scattered throughout the park for contemplative thinking or just plain enjoying the incredible views. Great place to relax with your dog or enjoy a picnic lunch.



MOLLIE GIBSON PARK

Elevated over the town is Mollie Gibson Park. Just north of town close to Smuggler Mountain Open Space is this peaceful park. This park has a very wide sloping lawn area, perfect for most park activities, parties, and other events. Mollie Gibson Park has some of the best views overlooking the City of Aspen & surrounding mountain vistas.



HARMONY PARK

Truly a place of beauty, Harmony Park is located adjacent to the Burlingame neighborhood. This new two-acre neighborhood park includes an approximate ½ acre play lawn, age separated play areas, naturalistic water features, picnic table areas, native landscape zones and large land forms that can function as sledding hills in wintertime.



SNYDER PARK

Snyder Park is another hidden gem within are park system. This park is mainly geared toward storm water control. The first thing you will find is a beautiful pond and waterfall that makes a very intimate setting for any user. Further in the park there is a playground, picnic table, parking, restroom, and benches within the park for you to use at your leisure.



JENNIE ADAIR WETLANDS

Jennie Adair Wetlands is a large storm water wetland control area. This large parcel attracts many different species of wildlife throughout the year. On the southern edge of the park is a small grass lawn with a few picnic tables. If you venture further into the property you will find a walking trail with interpretive signage explaining the history of the site.



YELLOW BRICK PARK

Accompanied by an abundance of shade, Yellow Brick Park is located just north of the downtown core off of Bleeker Street and Garmisch Street. This park is adjacent to the Yellow Brick Day School and has an epic playground for most age ranges. Furthermore there is a full size basketball court, a picnic shelter with two tables, and an open lawn play area.
