

INFORMATION GUIDE FOR:

FENCES

- **DEFINITION**

A constructed barrier, including berms, intended to prevent escape or intrusion, or to mark a boundary or shield or screen view, or to perform any similar function.

- **AREAS WHERE FENCES ARE PERMITTED:**


Fences shall be permitted in every zone district provided that no fence shall exceed six (6) feet above natural grade **or as otherwise regulated by the Residential Design Standards or the Commercial Design Standards.**

- **MATERIALS PERMITTED FOR FENCES:**

Fences visible from the public right-of-way shall be constructed of wood, stone, wrought iron or masonry. On corner lots, no fence, retaining wall, or similar object shall be erected or maintained which obstructs the traffic vision,

- **FENCES ON CORNER LOTS:**

No fence or similar erected/maintained object on a corner lots shall exceed a height of forty-two (42) inches, measured from street grade within thirty (30) feet from the paved or unpaved roadway. See below.



- **PROCESS:**
Plans showing proposed construction, material , location and height shall be presented to the building inspector before a building permit for a fence is issued.

This is only a guide for the construction of fences in the City of Aspen. The official and full regulations are in the Land Use Code.
